Itinerary

- **7:30 am** Departure from Memorial Union, south entrance, which is the arrival time of the first [CyRide Red Line](#) bus.
- **7:45 am** Stop at SUV Laundry.
- **8:00 – 11:00 am** Drive to Minneapolis
- **11:00 am – 1:00 pm** Visit to [Mall of America](#) and/or [IKEA](#) in Bloomington/Minneapolis
- **1:00 – 2:00 pm** lunch at [Little Szechuan](#) (Chinese) in West End/St. Louis Park/Minneapolis
- **2:00 – 4:30 pm** Visit to [Minneapolis Institute of Arts](#) downtown Minneapolis. Free entrance, free Wi-Fi. There will be a special exhibition about [sports](#). Admission to that is \$8 per adult or \$6 per student or senior.
- **5:30 – 7:00 pm** Bethlehem Baptist Church, downtown Minneapolis, Famous preacher [John Piper](#). See his [preaching schedule](#) and his [free online books](#).
- **7:30 – 11:00 pm** Drive back to Ames. Stop at Subway in Faribault.

Transport
